We heard your requests and made some important changes:



Allow some food and drink in the library

Individual snacks and drinks with lids are allowed in all UNG libraries.
Lobbies are available for larger meals at Gainesville and Dahlonega.



Improve the library website and search tools

We redesigned the library homepage based on student usability studies.
It has integrated one-box searching, mobile-responsive design, and a new library catalog.



Expand library study spaces

The Oconee library added the annex group study space and remodeled the overall library space.
The Gainesville library added a large silent study room and new furniture. Stay tuned for new building plans!



Have more technology equipment to check out

All campus libraries now have digital cameras available to check out.



Offer more ebooks and online resources

We subscribed to new ebook packages and now provide approximately 434,000 ebooks.
We added over 40 new databases, so you now have access to over 125,000 online journals.



Add more librarians or tutorials to help with my research

We hired more librarians and staff to help with your research.
New online FAQs and video tutorials give you targeted help just when you need it.



Buy more books on my topic

We reviewed our collection and purchased items to support both existing and new classes.
We have added thousands of print books, ebooks, and DVDs since 2015.
