

University of North Georgia Petition for Classification of Students for Tuition Purposes

Section I- Overview

Students who have been classified as distant for tuition purposes who believe that the submission of additional information could alter that decision, may submit this petition and supporting documentation to be considered for reclassification. This petition should only besubmitted by students who have been notified that they have been classified as out-of-state for tuition purposes. Students wishing to file a petition should refer to the University of North Georgia website for submission deadlines.

Prior to completing this petition, students should carefully review these instructions. Section II—SupportingDocumentation

The following are examples of supporting documentation which may be submitted as evidence of domicile. The submission of any following documentation does not guarantee reclassification as attate-student. The tuition classification officer and appointed committee will consider the totality of circumstances when making a tuition classification.

- 11. Copy of a valid vehicle registration for the Stateofrgia.
- 12. Copy of a valid Georgia Driver's License or stateuedD.

- 14. Copyof anybusinessor professionalicense(s) which may have been obtained in Georgia.
- 15. Copies of bills, such as utilityills.
- 16. Copies of bankstatements.
