BS in Art Education Advising Guidance Document THINGS ART ED MAJORS NEED TO KNOW

- 1. Art Ed Majors are divided into two advising groups Art Education Pre Admission and Art Education Post Admission. Students will be assigned an advisor based on where they are in the program.
- 2. EDUCATION PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS: Students must complete the prerequisite sequence before applying to the Teacher Education Program. These courses include: EDUC 2110, EDUC 2120, EDUC 2130. EDUC 2110 must be taken first and completed before EDUC 2120 and 2130 can be taken. To ensure timely admission and progression in the art education program, the student should complete the prerequisite sequence as early as possible in their overall program of study, ideally complete as early as 60 credit hours and before 90 credit hours.
- 3. GACE Program Admissions: Students must sign up and pass GACE Program Admissions test
